Priority will be given to entries for the double 1440, single day entries will accepted for score and record only.

In an effort to encourage less experienced shooters to sample the atmosphere of a world record status shoot, Corus Deeside AC are pleased to open the Metric Rounds to all competitors regardless of age. If you are a senior shooter who cannot reach a FITA distance, please feel free to enter a shorter distance of your choice. The only restriction to this will be that shooters out of their correct age category will not be eligible for prizes or placement in the results table. Photography	All persons, amateur or professional, wishing to take pictures or films during the event must provide personal details and sign the Tournament Organiser's register.
Refreshments	<p>There are no bar facilities as the sports and social club has closed. Lots of takeaways in area.</p> <p>Café Corus will be up and running for hot snacks, drinks and cakes through both days.</p>
Parking	Car Parking and toilets are available all weekend. Please keep to the perimeter track when driving around the field and drive at a walking pace at all times.
Camping	<p>The grassy area to the right hand side of the field is for caravans and tent camping and is available from Friday afternoon.</p> <p>Please advise us if you are intending to bring a caravan as spaces are limited to around 20 caravans / motorhomes. There are toilets available and showers in the cricket pavilion.</p> <p>Archers camping on the field do so at their own risk and should ensure that their camping area is kept clean & tidy and does not cause nuisance to other archers.</p>
Drugs Testing	All archers will be liable for drugs testing and competitors approached to give samples must comply. Refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents or guardians must authorise drugs testing of junior archers on the entry form.
